## **CALL TO ORDER**

Call to Order Meeting Called to Order at 9:44 AM by Chief Tucker (in the absences of Dr. McCabe)

**REGULAR BUSINESS** 

Pledge of Allegiance Chief Tucker led the committee in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance

Dr. McCabe arrived and apologized for being late.

Motion Motion to approve the July 8, 2024 minutes made by Mr. Boggess and Seconded by Dep.

Chief Cox. Motion approved unanimously.

**OLD BUSINESS** 

Discussion 4a – Mr. Boggess reported in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter, 2024 summary statistic report noting that

the report submitted was missing some late information provided by Chief Faust which was due to a typo error in transcribing from report to database. The tool has been corrected and the summary report will be corrected with the next quarterly report in

Lt. Jon Moscowitz, FCFR

November 2024. None of the private providers submitted data as required.

Motion 4b – The new data report form was used by Lt. Moscowitz and was found workable and

functional. Chief Tucker reported he is working with County IT to get the form made available on-line. Motion made to approve the new form and for it to be effective with the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarterly report, 2024. Motion seconded by Chief Tucker. Motion approved

unanimously.

Discussion 4c – Dr. McCabe is still working with AdventHealth to get the data needed for the

quarterly reporting. On another front, however, AdventHealth is working identifying

critical data points and fine-tuning outcome data.

Discussion 4d – Dr. McCabe indicated, as part of the discussion under 4c, that AdventHealth was

working on outcome data to meet some of the needs for Stroke Center certification and the hospital is now targeting February 2025 to make the application understanding that the process after that will take time as well. There was extensive conversation on the

need to structure the data in such a way so as to provide the data possible.

Discussion Chief Tucker noted that the State was restructuring the EMS Local Grants so that the

money goes directly to the individual counties. State Matching Grant funds will not

change.

Discussion 4e – Lt. Moscowitz reported that the alternate source for the Lucas device did not work

out but did manage to work with the manufacturer of the Lucas Device to arrive at an agreeable price and are now proceeding with the purchase of the Lucas Devices.

Discussion 4f – Chief Tucker demonstrated the new AED Inventory and Mapping application that will

be made available to dispatchers and crews in the field. At this point only those AED available at government buildings and facilities have been mapped as private business seem reluctant to disseminate information about their AEDs. Chief Tucker also noted that he is working with the various departments to standardize makes and models of AED so

that they can have an interchange of batteries, supplies, etc.

Discussion Dep. Chief Cox reported that they have worked with dispatch and now when they are

working trauma alerts, dispatch is providing timer information to the crew so that they are made aware how long they have been on scene. Chief Cox also reported that they have been working with the FC Sheriff's Office on "Active Assault" (or Active shooter)

training.

**NEW BUSINESS** 

Motion 5a-c Mr. Boggess went over the paperwork provided to the committee and that a single

copy of the COPCN application for City of Palm Coast, City of Flagler Beach, and County of Flagler were available for review. Motion by Chief Tucker to approve all three (3) applications and submit them to the Flagler Board of County Commissioners with the

recommendation of their approval and issuance of COPCN for a two (2) year period.

Seconded by Chief Faust. Motion approved unanimously.

Discussion With reference to the new COPCN application, it was suggested that government entities

should not be required to submit financial data. Mr. Boggess said he would add a "Not Appliable for Government Operated Providers" check box for that section along side a fee

schedule, non-applicable check box for non-transport, first responder applications.

Discussion 5c-e – Mr. Boggess reported on pending federal legislative items affecting EMS, Key

Performance Indicators (KPI) applicable to EMS, as well as a pending rule from Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) adding O+ Whole Blood administration to the ALS Level 2 list of authorized services. Chief Tucker indicated that, and other items, are included in some very preliminary discussions on services provided for the future.

New Discussion Chief Tucker reported that the County entered into a contract for 3<sup>rd</sup> party billing with

Digitech replacing Optimum.

Adjournment Dr. McCabe asked for a motion to adjourn. Motion made by Chief Tucker and seconded by

Chief Faust. Motion passed unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 11:30 pm
