Hurricane Milton storm debris collection for public roadways in unincorporated Flagler County completed

November 14, 2024 – With the exception of a few gated subdivisions, Hurricane Milton storm debris has been collected from all public roadways in the unincorporated areas of Flagler County.

“We are continuing to coordinate with our regular waste hauler, WastePro, to complete debris collection within a few remaining gated subdivisions over the next week,” said Engineering Project Manager Amy Stroger.

Regular trash and yard waste collection will return to its normal process and guidelines.

The Flagler County Solid Waste Division contracts with Waste Pro to collect household waste, recyclables, and green yard waste for the unincorporated areas in the county. The collection of garbage and recyclables within the municipalities is managed by each city agency, with some using private solid waste management companies, and some using in-house resources.
