## **Creating Stormwater District**

### Stormwater Project Details Total Costs over \$15 million

Project Costs to Date approximately **\$7 Million** Land \$5.7 million, Easements, Design, Other Project Costs Remaining **\$8.9 Million** Outside Money to Date **\$5.1 Million** 

Phase I \$2.9 Million Residents Pay Nothing Starts Early 2017
New Outfall/Backbone Final Construction Design Underway

Phase II \$2.5 Million Marineland Acres District Residents – Pay approx \$1 million Pond/Central Collection Pond Currently Under Design Construction forcast 2018

Phase III \$3.5 Million Marineland Acres District Residents - Pay approx. ½ million Street Laterals/Paving Design - After July 2017 Construction - After July 2019

#### North MalaCompra Basin Stormwater District Details

**Proposes 1<sup>st</sup> Year Operation and Maintenance Assessment** 

\$30

- Maximum amount of assessment can be \$75 annually.
- Assessment was initally priced at \$60 with County absorbing half to reduce costs.
- Assessment is expected to continue indefinitely.
