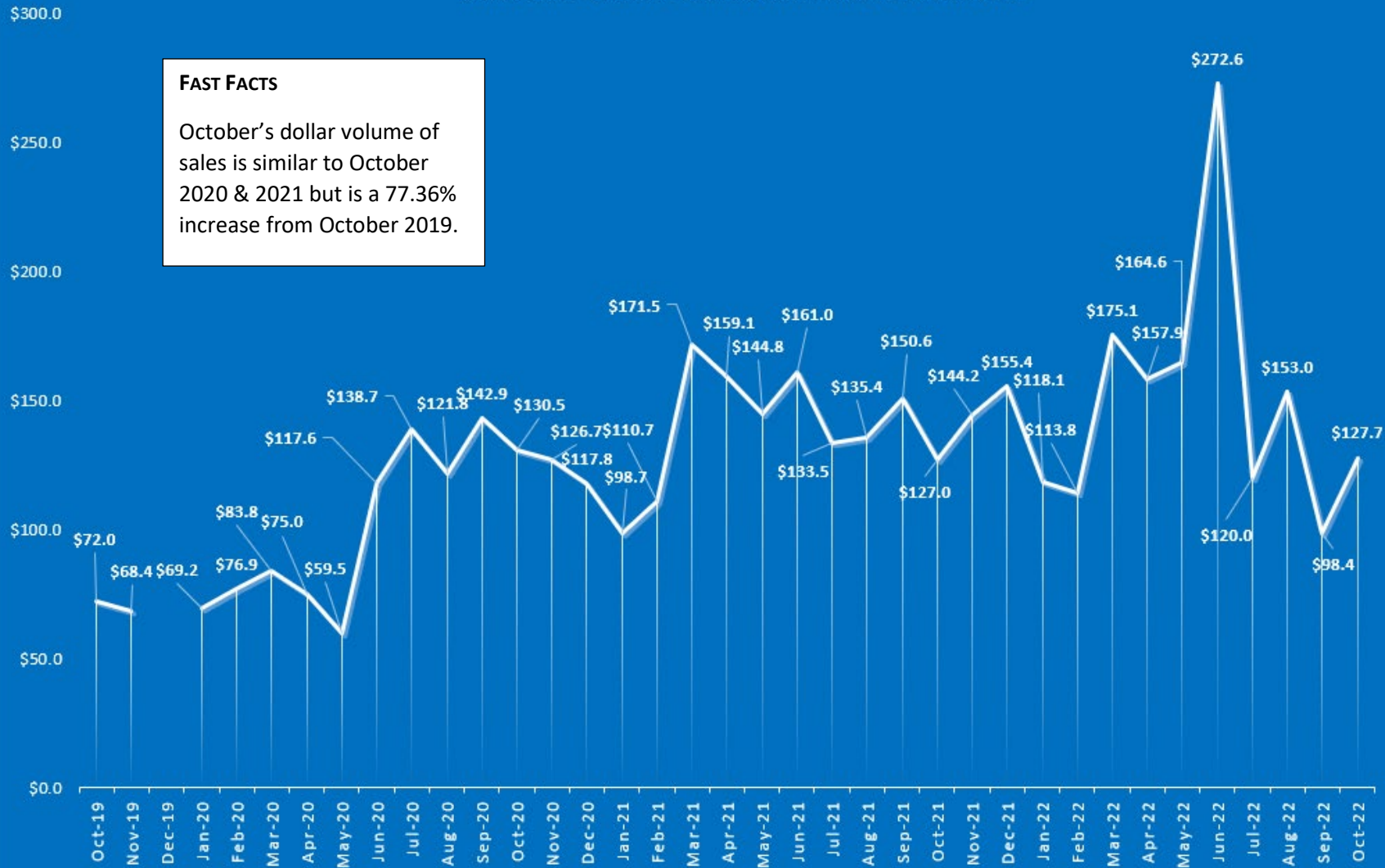


### RESIDENTIAL SALES | DOLLAR VOLUME IN MILLIONS

SINGLE FAMILY, TOWN HOME/CONDO & MANUFACTURED SALES COMBINED

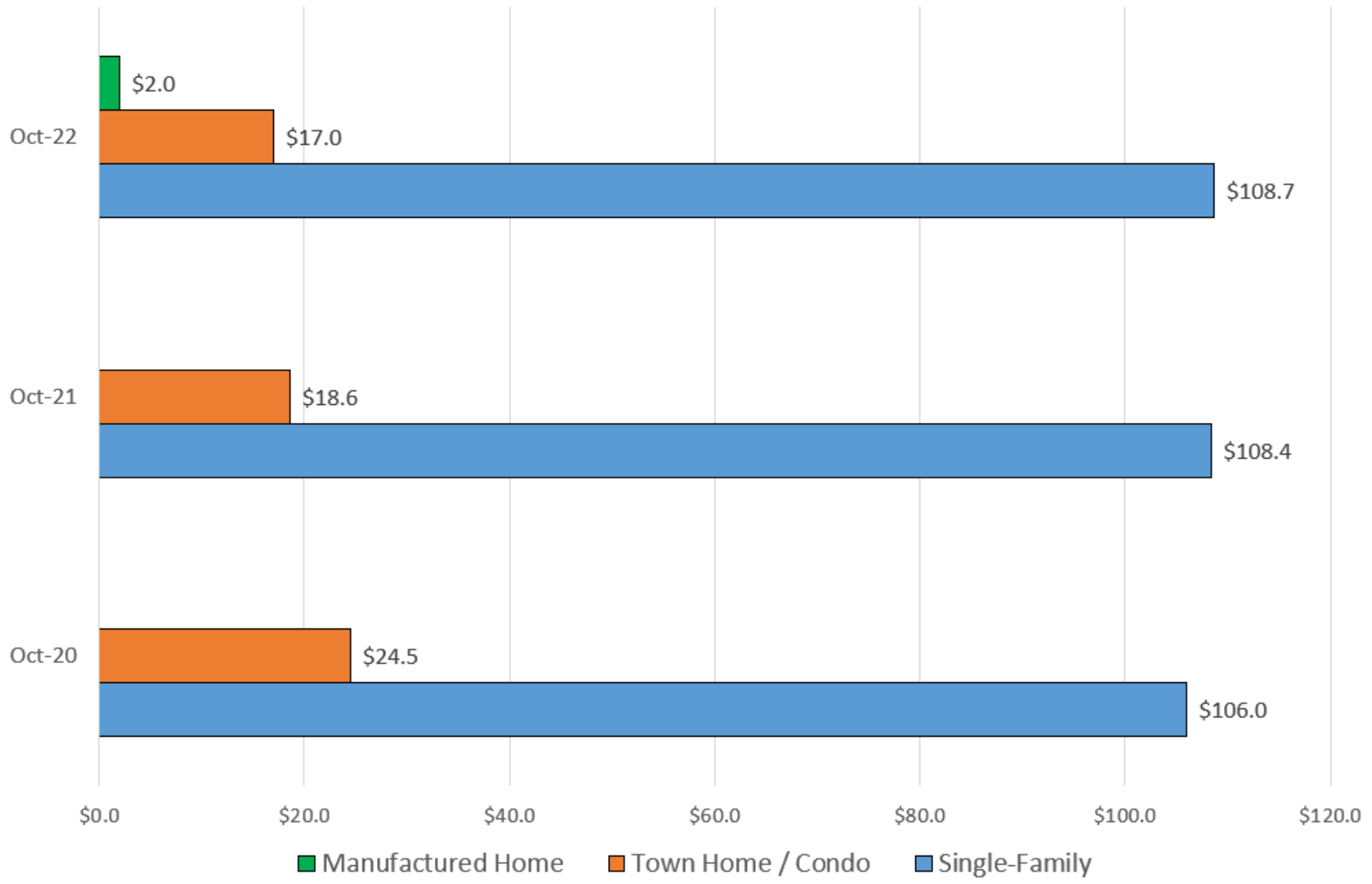

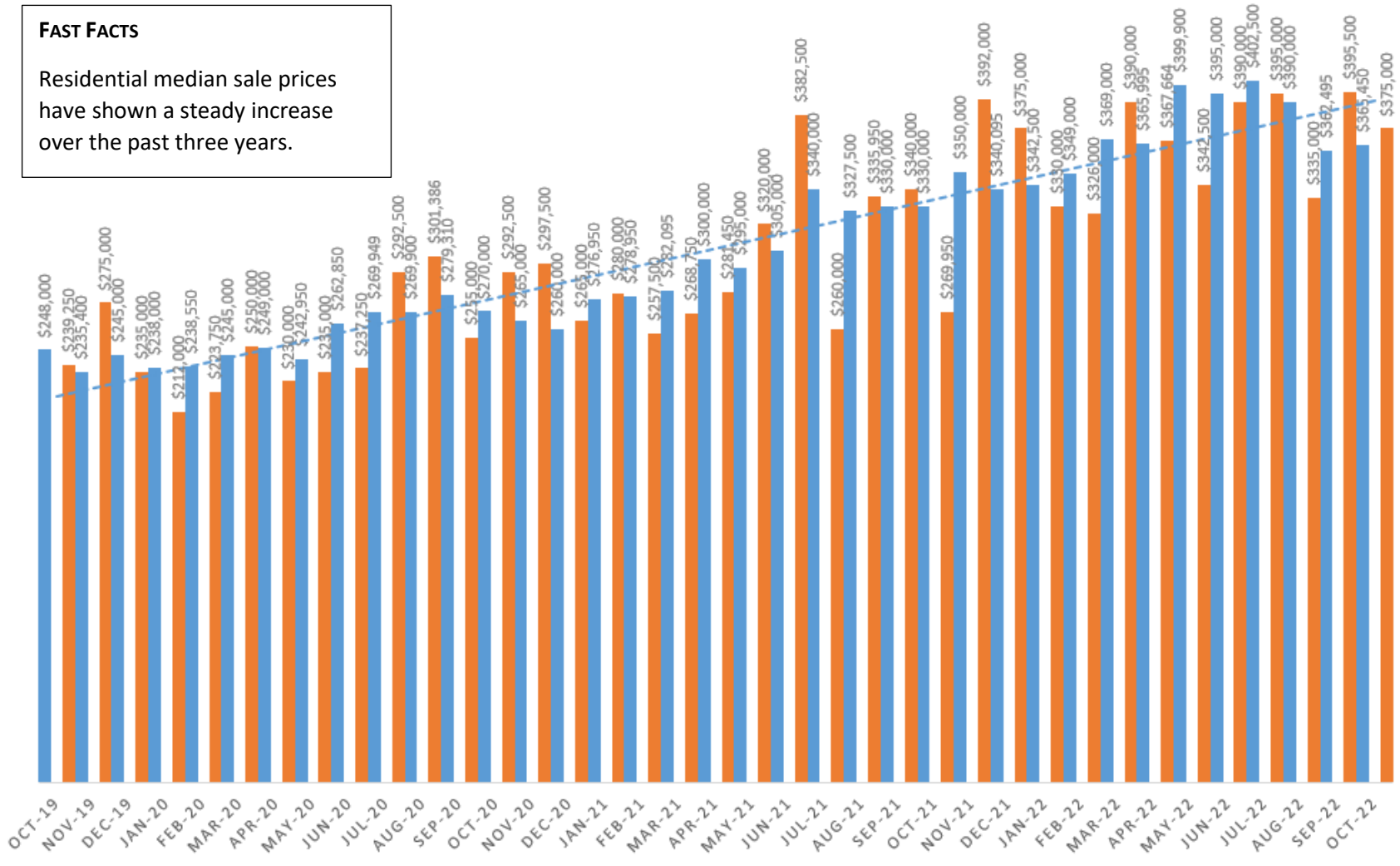


HISTORICAL VIEW | RESIDENTIAL MEDIAN SALE PRICE | FLAGLER COUNTY

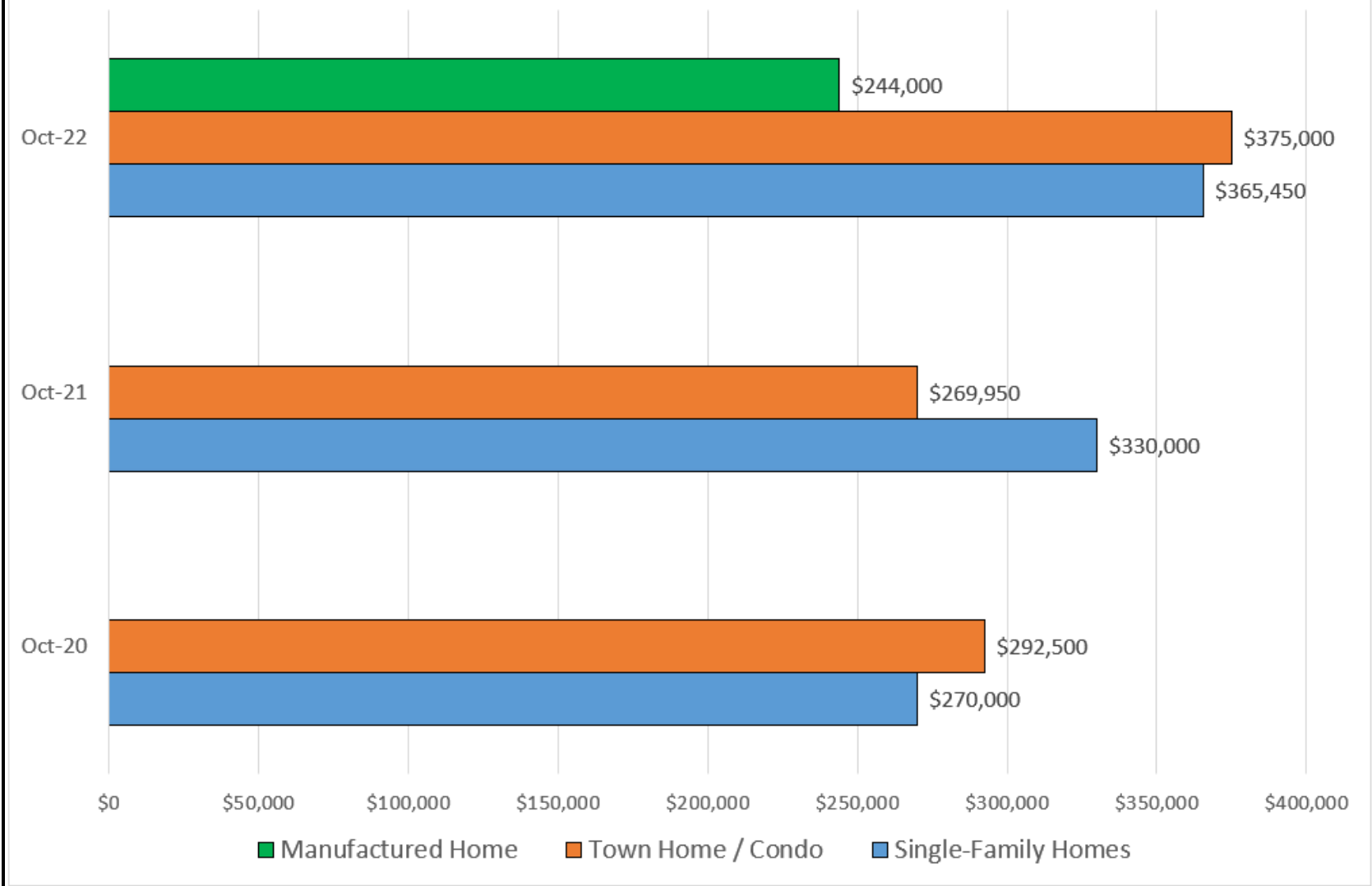

Residential median sale prices have shown a steady increase over the past three years.



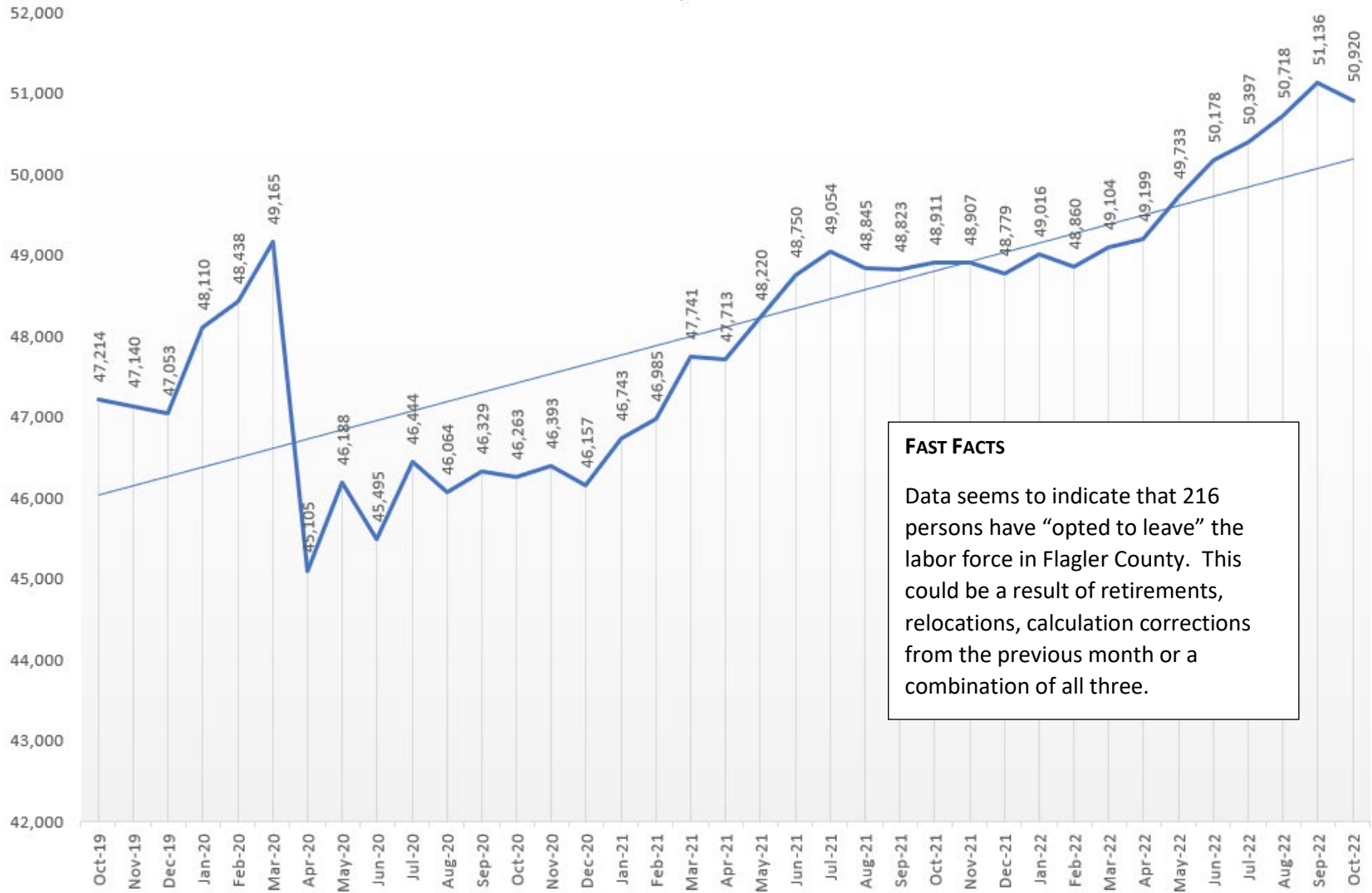
### RESIDENTIAL REAL ESTATE: MEDIAN SALE PRICE

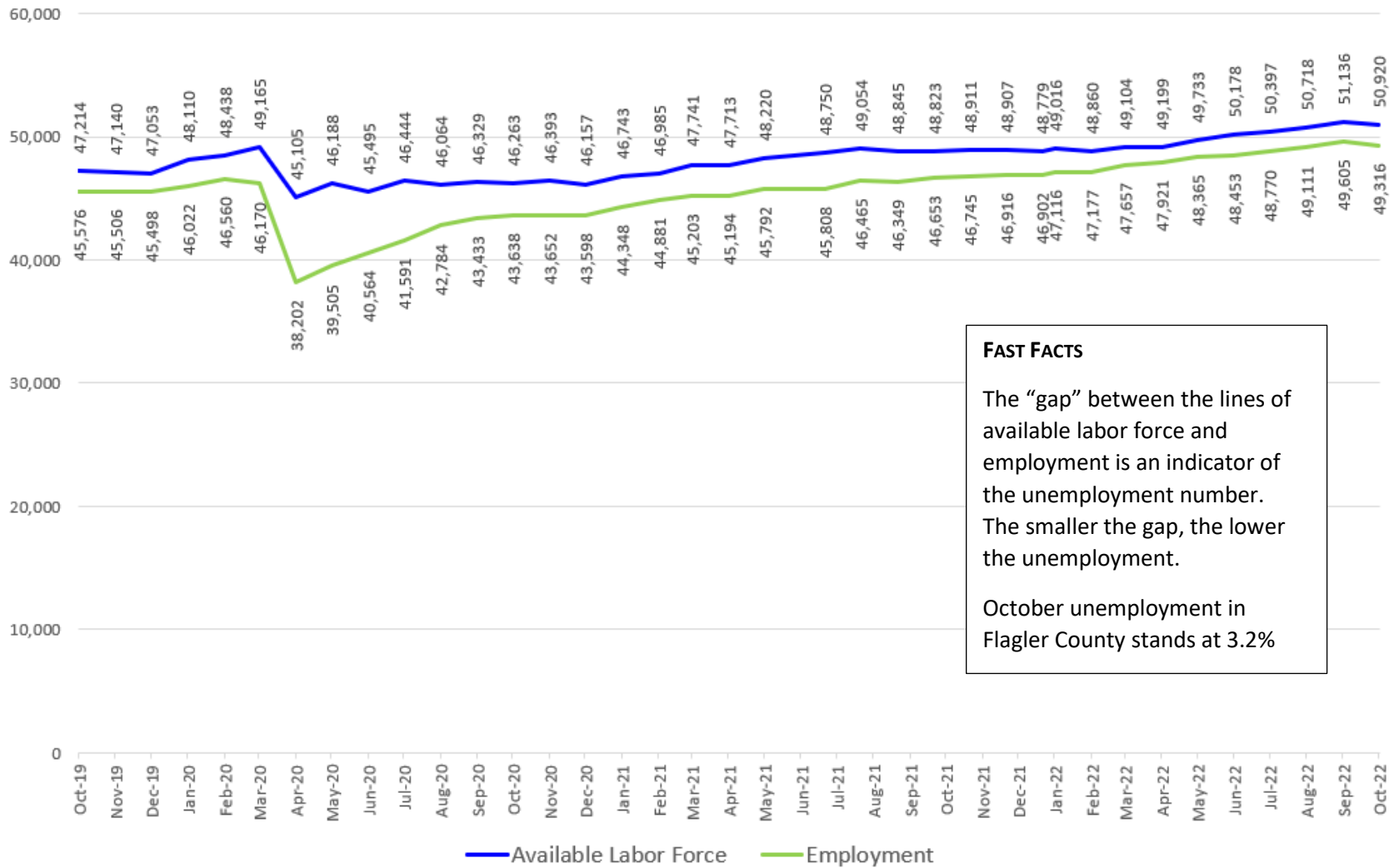
### LABOR FORCE RESIDING IN FLAGLER COUNTY

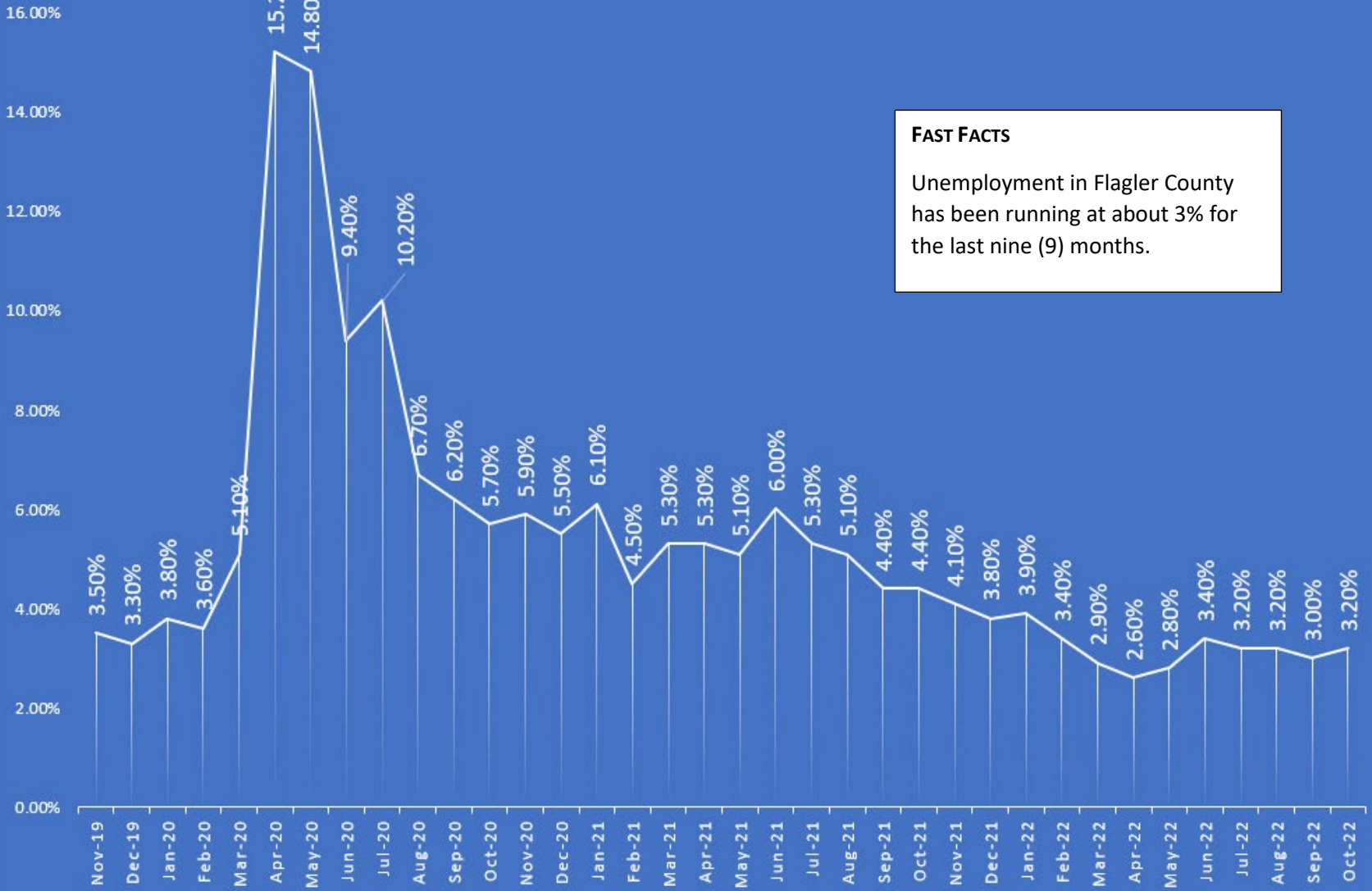
**FAST FACTS**
