TYPES OF ELECTRIC BICYCLES PEDAL ASSIST VS THROTTLE ASSIST



CLASS 1

Low-Speed Pedal Assist Motor provides assistance only when the rider is pedaling up to 20 mph



CLASS 2

Low Speed Throttle Assist Motor may be used exclusively to propel the bicycle up to 20 mph



CLASS 3

Speed Pedal Assist Motor provides assistance only when the rider is pedaling up to 28 mph

Flagler County Parks E-Bike & E-Devices Suggested Rules

- Paved Trails Greater than 6' Wide
 - Class 1 & Class 2 Allowed
 - Class 3 Not Permitted
 - Speed Limit 15 MPH (All wheeled modes of transportation that is allowed on path. Examples would be Bicycles, E-Bikes, Skateboards, 1 Wheelers, Hoverboards, Hovarounds, etc.)

• Graham Swamp MTB & Mala Compra MTB

- Class 1 Allowed
- Class 2 & Class 3 Not Permitted
 - And all forms of movement that are not human powered
- Unpaved Multiuse & Walking Trails
 - Class 1 Allowed
 - Class 2 & Class 3 Not Permitted (And anything else that is not human powered)
 - Speed Limit 15 MPH




Program Roll Out Ideas

- Signage at all trail heads and entrances to trails
- Flagler County Sheriff's Office
 - Opportunity for the FCSO Bicycle Officers to ride the trails & educate on safe trail use before enforcement (Possible reward those doing it correctly with free movie tickets or free passes to an event)

House Bill No. 105

Giving authority to the counties and municipalities to restrict smoking within the boundaries of any public beaches and public parks.

Flagler Ordinance No. 2022-10

I would like to call upon line items 137-141

BEACH

(21) Smoke cigarettes, filtered cigars, or pipes, or use any other devices to inhale smoke from burning tobacco products within a city owned public park, beach, or boardwalk, unless such activity occurs in an area designated for smoking or tobacco use by posted signage. For purposes of this paragraph, the term smoking shall mean the inhaling, exhaling, burning, carrying, or
possessing any lighted tobacco product.

Flagler Ordinance No. 2022-10

I would like to call upon line items 34-45

Whereas, the City Commission desires to protect the aesthetic beauty and environmental health of the City's public parks and beaches; and

Whereas, the exposure to second hand smoke is known to cause numerous health problems and has been casually linked to cancer and other potentially fatal diseases; and

Whereas, the City Commission desires to enable residents and visitors to enjoy the City's public parks without exposure to unhealthy second hand smoke; and

Whereas, the City Commission finds that this Ordinance serves the public interest and is necessary and appropriate to protect health, safety and welfare.

Oviedo Ordinance No. 1628

(a). Smoking or holding lighted tobacco products, including the use of e-cigarettes, and use or consumption of tobacco products, in or upon parks, properties or facilities under the control and management of the City Council of the City of Oviedo is prohibited and unlawful. It is prohibited and unlawful for any person to smoke or carry a lighted cigar, cigarette, cigarillo or pipe, or use any sparks, flame, match or fire-producing device normally used in tobacco, smoking, or, to use or consume tobacco products, including ecigarettes, in any park, property, or facility under the control and management of the City Council. The City Manager, or designee(s) shall post signs reading "Smoking Prohibited by Law", which shall be conspicuously displayed in all appropriate locations.

Proposed Changes

Adopt Oviedo Language and ban all smoking in Flagler Parks.

Remove smoking signs next to the field and build a smoking box near the entrance of the park by the road.

Proposed Changes

 Remove Parking area next to fields 1 and 4. Astro turf the area and add a playground and move signs to far end of parking lot.
